

# Annual Capital Expenditures Survey

The Annual Capital Expenditures Survey (ACES) provides the only national-level estimates of annual capital investment in new and used buildings, structures, machinery, and equipment (including computer software) by U.S. non-farm businesses with employees and without employees. The ACES data on the amount of business expenditures for new plant and equipment and measures of the stock of existing facilities are critical to evaluate productivity growth, the ability of U.S. business to compete with foreign business, changes in industrial capacity, measures of overall economic performance, and to support informed decision making by businesses and government leaders.

## Why did I receive this survey?

United States Code Title 13, authorizes this survey and makes responding **mandatory**. United States Code Title 13 also protects the **confidentiality** of respondents and the data they provide. It is important that we receive a response from each business surveyed.
