



NOTICE OF FAILURE TO PROVIDE MANDATORY CENSUS BUREAU REPORT

The U.S. Census Bureau, an agency of the U.S. Department of Commerce, has informed me that your company has failed to report information for the 2015 Report of Organization, NC-99007, and the 2015 Annual Survey of Manufactures, MA-10000(L). High-quality economic statistics are indispensable to understanding our domestic economy, and most models of our economy depend on data from this survey.

Your company has received repeated requests for this information. Despite these requests, no response has been received.

Title 13 of the United States Code, Sections 182 and 224, requires that your company furnish the requested information. By Section 9 of the same law, your report is confidential. Your continued failure to respond may subject responsible officials of your business to prosecution, with penalties up to \$5,000.
